SYSTON BOWLING CLUB - WORKING FOR THE COMMUNITY

WORK has started on the extension to Syston Bowling Club clubhouse in Central Park. The project, funded by a £40,000 grant from the Sport England Olympic Legacy Inspired Facilities fund will provide much-needed additional changing room and toilet facilities for this growing club. With the help of a separate grant from the Lafarge Aggregate & Concrete UK Landfill Communities Fund, managed by the Derbyshire Environmental Trust, a new ramp running between the main clubhouse doors and the entrance to the green, enabling full disabled access, will also be completed in the coming weeks. Subject only to weather, it is hoped to have the works completed by the end of March.

Club Chairman, Colin Grimes, says: "We are delighted, after a deal of effort, to be in a position to further enhance our clubhouse to make it a more welcoming place, not only for our own membership but for the hundreds of visiting players that we host from all parts of Leicester.

As a Club, we see ourselves as the current custodians of a vitally important community resource. We do everything possible to attract as many of the local community as we can to share in the benefits of the wonderful sport of bowling and, at the same time, through the warmth of our hospitality and the quality of facilities, make every effort to promote the reputation of Syston as an attractive town to our many visitors.

We are currently planning an official opening ceremony for the ramp and the extension at some time in April and are hopeful of attracting a high profile personality to lead the event. This should attract media attention to the Club and to the Town which, in turn, will hopefully lead to further growth in our membership and more visitors to Syston.
